Ross W. Greene, Ph.D. is the originator of the innovative, empirically-supported approach known as *Collaborative & Proactive Solutions* (CPS), as described in his influential books *The Explosive Child* and *Lost at School*, and the newly released books *Lost & Found* and *Raising Human Beings*. Dr. Greene served on the teaching faculty at Harvard Medical School for over 20 years, and is currently adjunct associate professor in the Department of Psychology at Virginia Tech. He is also Founding Director of the non-profit *Lives in the Balance*, which provides vast, free, web-based resources on the CPS model; provides support and advocacy for behaviorally challenging kids and their caregivers; takes a strong stand against use of corporal punishment at home and school, the use of restraint and seclusion in schools and restrictive therapeutic facilities, and the use of detention, suspension, and expulsion in schools, preschools, and daycare settings; and advocates for interventions that are non-punitive and non-adversarial. Dr. Greene lectures and provides consultation to families, schools and restrictive therapeutic facilities throughout the world and lives in Portland, Maine, with his wife and two kids.
