### **2017 North American Indigenous Games (NAIG)**

### **CHAPERONE VOLUNTEER APPLICATION**

The PEI Aboriginal Sports Circle (PEIASC) is now accepting applications for three (3) North American Indigenous Games volunteer CHAPERONE positions. The Games will take place from July 15-23, 2017, in Toronto, Ontario.

Team PEI is overseen by the PEIASC. Our team will consist of 28 athletes, 7 coaches, 3 chaperones and 2 mission staff.

### **CHAPERONE POSITION DESCRIPTION**

In conjunction with the PEIASC staff and coaches, chaperones will participate in supervision and guidance of athletes attending the Games. Chaperones are required to abide by the policies, rules and regulations and other guidelines handed down by the Mi'kmaq Confederacy of PEI, the NAIG Council and the Ontario 2017 Host Society.

### **GENERAL ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CHAPERONE POSITION**

- **Pre-Games:** Assist coaches with chaperone duties at practices and events.
- **Games-time:** In partnership with coaches/managers, 24/7 supervision of the athletes is required. This means you will be with the team at all times during the NAIG event. The chaperone will also be doing perimeter and bed checks at curfew.
- **Post-Games:** Written evaluation of the 2017 games experience will be required.

### **CRITERIA**

- Must be at least 20 years of age when application is submitted
- Must be of good character.
- Must be physically fit (ability to stand for long periods of time; ability to walk long distances)
- First Aid an asset
- Valid Driver's License an asset

The selected Chaperones will be given Team PEI wear. All accommodations, transportation and meals will be provided for the event, if chosen.
