



Child and Youth Support Worker  
Abegweit First Nation

The Mi'kmaq Confederacy of PEI's Child and Family Services Program, provides family support and prevention services to Lennox Island and Abegweit First Nation families. The Child and Youth Support Worker will work under the supervision of the Abegweit PRIDE Program Team Supervisor and will work closely with the program's family support worker, family therapist and existing child and youth care worker. The primary focus of the position will be to provide individualized services to children, youth and their families.

Location: Scotchfort

Hours of work: Full time, evenings and weekends required.

Duties will include:

- Individual and group work with children and young people;
- Work with families and other helpers in planning, implementation of case actions and evaluations of outcomes;
- Engage children and youth in programs such as self esteem, life skills, peer relations, conflict resolution, behavior management, social skill development and family relationships;
- Mentorship and capacity building;
- Maintain and provide case documentation including daily case recordings, written and oral evaluations;
- Other duties as required

Minimum Qualifications:

- Knowledge of PEI First Nation Communities;
- Completion of a recognized educational program such as child and youth care worker, or equivalent with training and experience;
- Two years experience directly related to this type of position;
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Must have strong interpersonal and collaborative skills;
- Must have excellent organizational skills;
- Must have demonstrated excellent problem solving, conflict resolution and facilitation skills;
- Excellent written and oral communication skills are required;
- Must have a valid driver's license and use of a reliable motor vehicle;
- A good previous work and attendance record

The successful applicant will be required to provide proof of an acceptable security check and proof of \$2,000,000 liability insurance on vehicle.

If all qualifications are equal, preference will be given to persons of Aboriginal ancestry. While we appreciate the interest of all applicants, only those applicants selected for an interview will be contacted. No interview or relocation costs will be provided.
