- College level education (or equivalent) combined with experience preferably in the field of health and social work and therapeutic practices
- Knowledge of Indian Residential Schools and culturally safe practices
- Ability to professionally liaise with all stakeholders

- Ability to identify priorities, and maintain a detailed work plan;
- Ability to use analytical and problem solving skills;
- Ability to demonstrate effective verbal, presentation and listening skills;
